Since earning the Pathfinder Award, plan and conduct a service project as described in the Venturing Summit Award Service Project Workbook, No. 512-938. This project must be a different service project than one carried out for the Eagle Scout rank, the Sea Scout Quartermaster Award, or the Girl Scout Gold Award.
